- Anne Morrow Lingbergh** (1st U.S. woman glider pilot, 1931)
- Phoebe Fairgrave Omlie** (1st Woman to obtain an Aircraft Mechanics License, 1927)
- Harriet Quimby** (1st U.S. woman to earn a pilot certificate and cross the English Channel, 1927)
- Barbara Ann Rainey** (1st woman pilot in the U.S. military, 1974)
- Sally Ride** (1st U.S. woman in space, 1983)
- Blanche Stuart Scott** (1st woman to solo an airplane, 1910)
- Mary Van Seyoc** (1st woman air traffic controller, 1942)
- Betty Stewart** (1st and only U.S. woman to win the World Aerobic Championships (WAC) and 1st person to win the WAC two consecutive times, 1980, 1982)
- Marjorie Stinson** (1st woman airmail pilot (1918)
- Louise Thaden** (1st winner of All Woman's Air Race, 1929)
- E. Lillian Todd** (1st woman to design and build aircraft, 1906)
- Bobbi Trout** (1st woman to perform in-flight aerial refueling, 1929)
- WASP** (Women Airforce Service Pilots, 1st U.S. women Pilots to fly military aircraft, 1942)
- WAVES** (Woman Accepted for Volunteer Emergency Service, 1st U.S. women navigators for the military, 1943)
- Patty Wagstaff** (1st woman to win the U.S. National Aerobic Champion title, 1991)
- Sheila Widnall** (1st woman Secretary of the Air Force, 1995-1997)
- Jeana Yeager** (Co-pilot of 1st around-the-world, non-stop, non-refueled flight, 1986)
